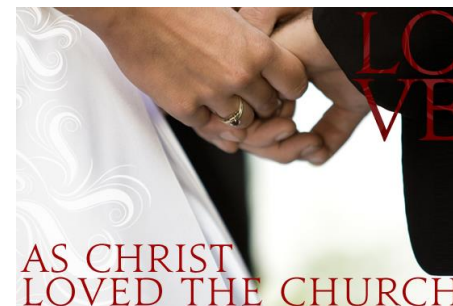
God's Word for the Week
