

There are fewer places darker than a prison cell, where men and women struggle with hopelessness and despair separated from all they've known and loved. They wonder if anyone outside knows or cares about their struggles.

But even in the darkest places there is Light. As we share Jesus' good news with those behind bars, offering hope of transformation and redemption, lives are forever changed.

Through the power of God's living Word and the devotion of many loving volunteers, hopefulness is restored and darkness replaced with the promise of a future in joyful service of the Lord.

The foundation of Spirit Led Spirit Fed Ministry was laid in 2012, when a vision given to me while serving prison time was put into action. I was set on a path of service that would ultimately lead to the growth of a massive prison outreach service throughout the United States.

Today our pen pal ministry serves nearly 1000 inmates across more than 40 states, matching them with pen pal volunteers who can share the hope and encouragement these men and women need. Still, countless thousands of inmates are unreached by the gospel, and numerous believers are surviving without the encouragement of their brothers and sisters on the outside.

We are God's servants, humbly called to a new season of growth for this ministry, spreading the gospel behind bars and bringing the life-giving salvation of Christ to more inmates than ever before.

## HOW WE CHANGE LIVES

### Evangelism

We share personal testimonies of God's power at work in our own lives, offering encouragement through pen pal relationships, newsletters, events and more.

### Resources

We provide for the needs of inmates, spiritually with Bibles and study materials, physically with personal hygiene items and basic supplies, and emotionally with counseling, guidance and prayer.

### Community

We nurture communities of disciples, equipping local cells, regional groups and church bodies to spread the gospel of Jesus with the resources of the ministry.

### Mentorship

We train and empower disciples with skills in outreach mentoring, preparing them to assist former inmates on the road of seeking new life in Christ after prison.

### Discipleship

We make disciples as Jesus commanded in the Great Commission (Matthew 28:19). According to His Word, discipleship is *going, baptizing and teaching*.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Will my identity be secure?

Absolutely! You will send mail directly to them and responses will be addressed to our mail center, where they will be scanned and digitally delivered to you. We also ask that you use only your first name and refrain from oversharing personal information.

### What if we have nothing in common?

You will initially receive a profile for your pen pal with their hobbies, interests and spiritual needs. Introduce yourself and do not overthink it. Focus on sharing Bible verses, prayers and spiritual support.

### Do I need to be a member?

Not at all. We have pen pal volunteers from many churches and denominations. We welcome all born again believers.

### Can I request more than one pen pal?

Certainly! Many of our volunteers write to several different pen pals, building lasting friendships.

### What can I expect to get out of this?

According to one volunteer, "You will receive blessings on top of blessings, new friends, and the joy of God's service in the life of a needy person."
