Justice Is Done!

(1 Kings 3:16-28)

One time, two women each had a baby. One woman's baby died. Each of the women claimed that the living child was hers. King Solomon gave an order to cut the child in two and give half to each woman. The true mother begged for the child's life. She even said to give the child to the other woman. The second woman did not care if the child was cut in half. King Solomon gave the baby to the real mother.

All of Israel heard the story and knew that God was with King Solomon. God had given Solomon great wisdom.

For the Parents

In today's lesson, your child heard that King Solomon was a wise man. Wisdom is needed in life. God promises to give wisdom to all who ask (see James 1:5). This week, let your child see you asking God for wisdom. Emphasize the importance of going to God in prayer before you act or speak. You may also demonstrate asking God how you may best connect with your child to show how much you love him or her.
