This class will include:

- **All methods of creating lines, forms, light, dark, shade, perspective, using dots, lines, and crosshatching by applying different densities of soft graphite, and hard graphite pencils.**
- **The use of projectors or free hand will both be encouraged.**
- **Composition and balances of background, foreground, and negative space with multiple subject matters from multiple photos will be utilized.**
- **Pen and ink will be explored.**

Each student would be inspired to advance individually at their own pace. A student can also work on the drawing foundation of a current painting on canvas or paper.

Instructor: Thomas Domino - *aka* Tommy Tucker

After 31 years as a sign painter in Local 729 (Motion Picture Set Painters and Signwriters Union), Tommy retired in 2010. He worked in all the Major Studios in Hollywood and ran the Sign Department for Stephan J Cannell Productions in the 1980s. Tommy has a BFA degree from Herron School of Art in 1970 in Drawing and Painting. He also has his graduate work at USC where he taught drawing and painting to undergraduate students during his tenure as a teaching assistant while working towards his MFA. He attended Yale Summer School of Music and Art during the summer of 1969, one of 75 students awarded from many Art Schools and Colleges around the country. Recipient of the Kate and Cole Porter Scholarship from USC 1971-1972. Tommy has run his own sign companies since his 20's, all while working in the studios.
