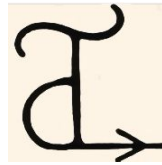
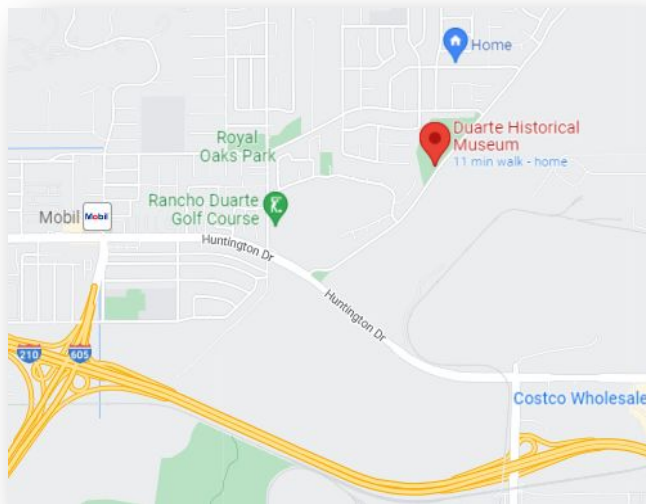
The mission of the Duarte Historical Society: to collect and preserve materials pertaining to the history of the City of Duarte and the San Gabriel Valley

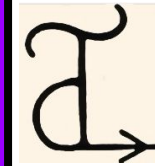
