The History of Play Therapy

The history of play therapy is a part of the continuing education requirements to become a Registered Play Therapist (RPT). We will explore the origins of today's major play therapy theories and historical contributions of professionals in the field. This workshop will ground you in play therapy theories so that you understand how they drive the play therapy approaches you use today. With knowledge of current play therapy theories and supporting research you can develop thoughtful and deliberate interventions with children.

5. Practice historically significant play therapy interventions that are still in use today.
