All in the Family: Working with Parents in Play Therapy and Integrating Filial Therapy into Play Therapy

This workshop focuses on how to develop a partnership with parents in their child's play therapy process. Facilitating parents' involvement in their child's play therapy requires assessment of their capacity, educating them about the therapeutic powers of play, and then guiding them in the level of participation that is the best fit for them and their child. Whenever possible, engaging parents in filial play therapy with their child has proven to be most effective. This workshop will provide tools for the effective use of the filial play therapy approaches.

Learning Objectives:

- 1. Evaluate the level of involvement parents should have in the Play Therapy Process based on a 4 stage scale.**
- 2. Identify 3 ways to engage parents in interacting positively with their child using Play Therapy Methods.**
- 3. Describe the theoretical basis for including parents in the playroom based on attachment issues, brain processes that support caregiving and the four Theraplay® dimensions.**
- 4. Explain and apply the 4 Filial Play Therapy skills to parents based on the 8 tenets of Child-Centered Play Therapy.**
- 5. Identify the 5 basic themes that occur in Play Therapy and how to aid parents in interpreting themes.**
- 6. Explain brain systems in a parent friendly way that will allow parents to help their child regulate during a Filial Play Therapy session.**

7. Identify indications or contraindications of using of Filial Therapy with parents.
