All in the Family:

Play Therapy with Families

Parents sometimes bring their child into therapy with the attitude “fix my child”. They may not understand the relationship between what is happening in the family and their child’s misbehavior. Modalities used with families in Play Therapy seek to understand the child’s behavior in the context of their family and to help family members identify their role in family issues. Our goal with families is to strengthen the relationship in all family members using the language of the child – play. Family activities and games promote insight and change within the family. This hands-on workshop will teach activities to use with families as well as techniques for non-directive family play.

Learning Objectives: Participants will:

1. Describe the purpose and benefits of family play therapy instead of or as an adjunct to individual play therapy.
2. Utilize family assessment tools to create a roadmap or treatment plan for the family.
3. Compare the role of the therapist in family play therapy vs. individual play therapy.
4. Demonstrate core family therapist skills needed for both directive and non-directive family play therapy sessions.
5. Apply techniques for teaching parents how to design family rules and family meetings.
6. Practice ten play-based family activities that improve communication skills, change interactional patterns and strengthen relationships.
