Note from Pastor Gretchen



In a recent conversation with my aunt Clarice, who is 92, I asked her, "what are you up to these days?" She answered, "I am praying to God to find out why I'm still here." "And what are you hearing?" "I'm here to put more love in the world." and she laughed with delight. We talked about the ways she was putting more love in the world. I began to wonder, how I am putting love into the world?

On November 2, the congregations of the Southwestern Minnesota Synod of the ELCA will gather for Equipping Congregations Day at Peace Lutheran, in New London MN to focus on aspects of worship and congregational life together and ponder the question: "How can we get more people back in worship again?" Pastor Angie Larson from Calvary Lutheran Church in Alexandria, MN will be the keynote speaker, sharing from the experience of that church.

The church begins the month of November commemorating All Saints Day, which will be celebrated on November 3rd. It is a day to acknowledge the grief of loss and gratitude of beloved people who have gone before us in death, and celebration of new people who have become children of God through baptism. The day is a dynamic tension between loss and love, grief and gratitude, death and life. The witness of the church is there is goodness in both, the mercies of God and graces of God are present in the full spectrum of human life and death.

During this month our country remembers our veterans who have served military service and are serving, for those who have returned and those who

gave their life for our country. On Sunday November 10th we will honor our veterans in our prayers. I am grateful for your service. Included in this newsletter is offered a poem prayer from Pastor Meta Herrick Carlson from her book, "Speak it Plain."

November is also a time where the Arlington area churches gather for an ecumenical worship service on the Eve of Thanksgiving, November 27. This year the community will worship at Zion at 7pm. Come and lift your voices in prayer and praise, with gratitude and lament for all the gifts we have received from our gracious God. What are you grateful for?

What am I grateful for?

I am grateful for you, for this call to be your pastor, for inviting me to be with you in your life celebrations and woes and daily life. I am grateful for the gifts that each of you bring to the ministry we share. Your generous hospitality on Sunday morning, the sharing not only of food and coffee, but also your lives with one another. I am grateful for all the good things that you do in the community and the way we are inviting the community to be fed – at the Harvest Supper on November 1, and Thanksgiving Eve worship. I am grateful for all the ways we are becoming partner people with God and one another.

Then as the nights grow longer, the church begin a season of vigil, the season of Advent – we watch and wait with the prophets who see the world as it is and hope for the light of Christ to appear.
