## MAILING CHILDREN VIA PARCEL POST

In 1913, Mr. and Mrs. Jesse Beauge sent a 10 pound baby to his grandmother's home a mile away, cost 15 cents postage. They paid extra for insurance to make sure their son was delivered safely.

May Pierstorff gained fame for traveling through the mail on an Idaho mail car in 1914 to relatives nearby. Apparently the stamps paying the postal charges were affixed to her coat. Her journey was covered in a children's book called "Mailing May".

Later in 1914 the Postmaster General established a regulation that prevented the carrying of human beings in the US Mail.

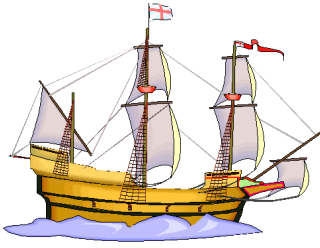
