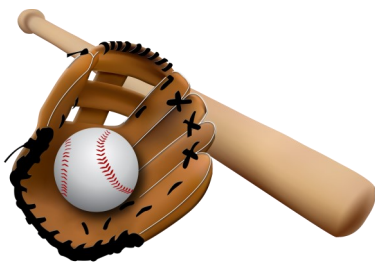


Show News

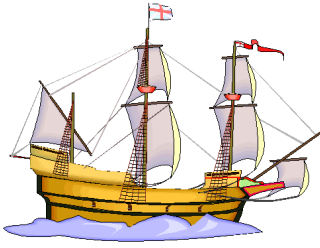
