## OLDEST POSTAL SERVICES IN THE WORLD

These postal services were established in China about 4000 BC and in Egypt and Assyria by 3000 BC. Like the Chinese, the Egyptians service was used mainly by court officials, while that in Assyria was apparently open to the merchant class as well. There is strong evidence to suggest that a well regulated service existed between Egypt and Syria and between the rulers of Assyria and Babylon.

## EARLIEST SURVIVING LETTERS

Early letters were clay tablets written in Cuneiform script and inserted in clay envelopes. They were transmitted by the royal court, merchants and individuals in Cappadocia (Asia Minor) and date from 3000 to 1500 BC .
