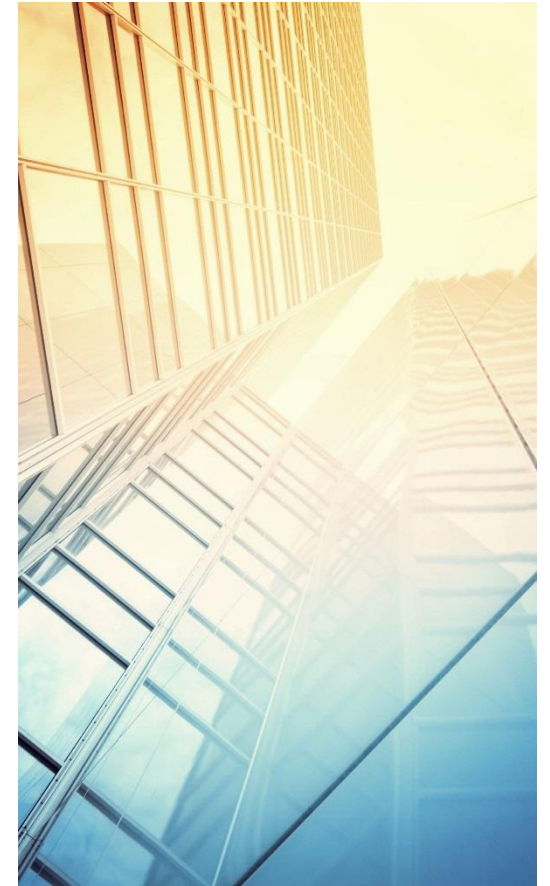

Individualized Service Plan (ISP)

Each resident receives an individualized service plan, which includes:

- Description of services that will be provided by the administrator, operations coordinator, staff and/or volunteers of Project Hope, Inc.
- Description of how the resident will obtain access to places in the community
- List and description of services provided by other services providers partnering with Project Hope, Inc. and how the services will be coordinated for the resident
- Description of personal housekeeping the resident agrees to perform

Service Agreement (SA)

Each resident receives a service agreement, which includes:

- Agreed upon rate of payment and method used for billing by the placing agency and the agency's process for paying Project Hope, Inc. for the services as well as room and board that is provided for each resident and the source of these funds. The method, frequency and anticipated payment dates shall also be specified in the agreement.
- A description of the space to be provided for the resident for sleeping, storage and any other uses along with a description of the typical number and times meals and snacks will be provided
- Any costs for which the resident will be liable and will be expected to pay including the rate and cost per unit or procedure for any services not covered by the placing agency
- Statement of the resident's rights
- Statement of conformity to conflict of interest policies
- Statements regarding control of resident's funds equal to or lower than two hundred dollars and means for separate accounting methods per resident
- Written explanation of termination procedures
